

SAMPLE BEQUEST LANGUAGE

Please note: If you decide to support The Tiller Foundation through a bequest in your Will, Testament, or Living Trust, we strongly recommend that you consult an attorney to prepare these documents to ensure compliance with your state requirements. Below are examples of possible ways in which your bequest can be made:

1. Unrestricted Bequest

An unrestricted gift by Will or Living Trust is especially helpful in supporting the work of the The Tiller Foundation. Possible language would be:

I give, devise, and bequeath to The Tiller Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, EIN #47-5005677 at PO Box 760 Pine Arizona 85544-0760 USA, the sum of _____Dollars [or personal property] [or percentage of my estate] [or rest, residue and remainder of my estate] to be used for the benefit of The Tiller Foundation as its Council may determine.

2. Restricted Bequest

A restricted bequest is a gift that must be used for a specific purpose(s). Such a bequest might read as the sample above except that the following wording would be added at the end:

...for scholarships for young Psychoenergetic Science students deemed by The Tiller Foundation, or its appointed committee to be worthy of support.

...for an endowment to a major University to house Dr Tiller's archive research papers and Psychoenergetic Science research lab.

...for an endowment to support the open access publications of The Tiller Foundation archives, as determined by The Tiller Foundation Council, or its appointed committee.

3. Real Estate

For a gift of specific property, possible language would be:

I give, devise, and bequeath my residence at 101 Main Street, Hometown, Ohio, to The Tiller Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, to be used, including the proceeds therefrom, if sold, for its general purposes as its Council may determine.
